**Author's last name, first name. Title of Book. Place of Publication: Publisher, Date of Publication**

Gouday, Alice. Here Come the Eagles. New York: Viking Press, 1999.

Books with two authors:

**Author's last name. Title of Book. Place of Publication. Publisher, Date of Publication.**

Liers, Emil and Paul Smith. Chemical Elements. New York: Viking Press, 2002.

## Encyclopedias:

Encyclopedia article with author:

**Author's last name, first name. "Title of Article." Title of Encyclopedia. Latest copyright date, Volume number, Page numbers.**

Hill, John Eric. "Animal." The World Book Encyclopedia. 1995, Vol. 1, pp. 444-474.

Encyclopedia article with no author given:

**"Title of Article." Title of Encyclopedia. Latest copyright Date, Volume number, Page numbers.**

"Bobsledding." Academic American Encyclopedia. 2000, Vol. 2, p.353-354.

## World Wide Web Sources:

**Author's last name, first name. "Title of item." Name of Site. <http://address>, Date.**
